

Integrated Terminal Management (iTM)

Quick Start Guide



iTM Installation

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iTM System Installation Process

Before installing the iTM software for the first time:

- Ensure that you have a valid entitlement for using the system.
- Check that Microsoft® Windows® Operating System is installed and appropriately configured on the iTM computers.
- Verify Adobe® Reader® is installed on all iTM computers.
- When installing iTM software, be sure to be logged in as Administrator or to have administrative rights.

Additionally for iTM Enterprise:

- Contact your network administrator to verify that iTM computers are configured on your LAN and to obtain the DNS name or IP address assigned to the iTM Server.
- Verify you are able to ping the server from the Proxy and Client PCs.
- Ensure the network firewall does not block the TCP port 8080 which is used by the iTM software.

iTM One Installation

1. Insert the iTM One software DVD into the DVD-ROM drive.
2. Browse the DVD-ROM content and double-click the iTMSingleBoxSetup32.exe file.
3. Select your preferred language for the InstallShield Wizard.
4. Follow the instructions in the InstallShield Wizard.

The process finishes with the successful installation notification.

iTM Enterprise Installation

1. Insert the iTM software CD-ROM into the CD/DVD drive.
2. Browse the CD-ROM content and double-click the following files:
 - MotorolaiTMServer.exe for iTM Server
 - MotorolaiTMProxy.exe for iTM Proxy
 - MotorolaiTMClient.exe for iTM Client
3. Select your preferred language for the InstallShield Wizard.
4. Follow the instructions in the InstallShield Wizard.

The process finishes with the successful installation notification.

Note: If required the iTM Client may be installed on the same PC that is running the iTM Proxy.

iTM Upgrade

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iTM System Initial Configuration Process


Before configuring the iTM software:

- Ensure that the iTM Server is installed on the iTM Server hardware platform.
- Ensure that an iTM Proxy is installed.
- Ensure that an iTM Client is installed.

1. Start the iTM Server.
2. Specify iTM Server address/name in iTM Client.
3. Specify iTM Server address/name in iTM Proxy.


iTM Server Start

1. Run **Start** → **Programs** → **Motorola** → **iTMServer** → **Start iTM Server** to start the iTM Server.
2. Press any key when prompted.




Specifying iTM Server Address in iTM Client

1. Start the iTM Client. From **Start** menu run **Programs** → **Motorola** → **iTMClient** → **iTMClient**.
2. Click **OK** in the **Server not found** dialog.
3. Type the iTM Server IP address or DNS name and click **OK** in the **Settings** dialog.




4. In the **iTM Client Login** dialog, in both the User Name and the Password fields enter **superuser** and click **OK**.



Before being able to use iTM you need to request an entitlement. Load the entitlement to activate iTM. For details on licensing see the iTM Online Help or the Client User Guide on the DVD.


Specifying iTM Server Address in iTM Proxy

1. Start the iTM Proxy. From **Start** menu run **Programs** → **Motorola** → **iTM Proxy** → **iTM Proxy**.
2. Type the iTM Server IP address or DNS name and click **OK** in the **Configure Proxy** dialog.




The **Proxy Needs Configuration** dialog appears.

3. Follow steps a. — f. to add the Proxy PC to the iTM Server.
 - a. Start the iTM Client and log into the application.
 - b. Click **Manage** → **Manage Proxies**.
 - c. Click **New Proxy** in the **Manage Proxies** dialog.




Specifying iTM Server Address in iTM Proxy (continued)

- d. Check the iTM Proxy name in the **Proxy Needs Configuration** dialog.




- e. Type the name in the **Proxy Name** field and click **OK**.



- f. Close the **Manage Proxies** dialog.

4. Go back to the **Proxy Needs Configuration** dialog and click **Retry**.
5. Log in as superuser.
