
Operation

- Do not fill the earpiece with water.

- Do not use the earpiece until completely dry.

This kit comes with an optional ear tip in three sizes for a better fit when used with the earpiece. You can rotate the ear tip to fit your left or right ear.

#### 180 Degrees Arbitrary Rotation






#### **Acoustic Safety**

Exposure to loud noises from any source for extended periods of time may temporarily or permanently affect your hearing. The louder the radio volume, the less time is required before your hearing can be affected. Hearing damage from loud noise is sometimes undetectable at first and can have a cumulative effect. To protect your hearing:

- Use the lowest volume necessary to do your job.
- Turn up the volume only if you are in noisy surroundings.
- Turn down the volume before attaching headset or earpiece.
  Limit the amount of time you use headsets

or earpieces at high volume.


Earpiece Overview




#### Ear Tip Attachment


