

Special Note:

When a Bluetooth device is connected to Evolve Radio in EVOLVE_R01.04.05 or earlier software and upgraded to EVOLVE_R02.00.14, WAVE PTX APP requires Nearby Devices permission. Launching the WAVE PTX APP first time after upgrade will prompt a message to enable this permission.

Please enable the Nearby Devices permission in the WAVE PTX app setting and either power cycle the Bluetooth device or toggle off and on Bluetooth on Evolve Radio. To enable the permission, long press the Wave app and select "App info", select "Permissions", select "Nearby devices", select "Allow".



*Limitation:

To upgrade from EVOLVE_R01.04.05 or earlier software to EVOLVE_R02.00.14, the upgrade has to be done manually, using an SD-Card provided by MSI. Please get in touch with your dealer or MSI support team to get this upgrade.

Future releases from EVOLVE_R02.00.14 onwards will be able to continue with Over-The-Air Updates as earlier practices on Android devices.
