Acoustic Safety

Exposure to loud noises from any source for extended periods of time may temporarily or permanently affect your hearing. The louder the radio volume, the less time is required before your hearing can be affected. Hearing damage from loud noise is sometimes undetectable at first and can have a cumulative effect. To protect your hearing:

- Use the lowest volume necessary to do your job.
- Turn up the volume only if you are in noisy surroundings.
- Turn down the volume before attaching headset or earpiece.
- Limit the amount of time you use headsets or earpieces at high volume.

- When using the radio without a headset or earpiece, do not place the radio speaker directly against your ear.
 - If you experience hearing discomfort, ringing in your ears, or muffled speech, you should stop listening to your radio through your headset or earpiece, and have your hearing checked by your doctor.
- To change the volume level, refer to the Radio Product Safety Leaflet.




Caution

Recommended Practice

- Do not cover the microphone port for optimum performance.
 - Do not fill the earpiece with water.
 - Clean the earpiece with soft damp cloth.
- Do not use the earpiece until completely dry.

- 1 – Earpiece Speaker
- 2 – Push-to-talk and Microphone Module
- 3 – Cloth Clip
- 4 – 2.5 mm Connector

Replaceable Parts

This kit comes with a default Medium-sized ear tip. Alternative sizes and their respective measurements are available in the following table.




Table 2: Ear Tip Size and Measurement

Size	Height (H)	Diameter (D)
Small	6.1 mm	12.5 mm
Medium	7.0 mm	13.0 mm
Large	8.5 mm	14.0 mm

Description

This user manual applies to PMLN8311_.

The earpiece is an over-the-ear accessory for devices with a 2.5-mm audio jack. It comes with an optional ear tip for a better fit when used with the earpiece. You can rotate the ear tip to fit your left or right ear.

Attaching the Ear Tip




Table 1: Locking and Unlocking Ear Tip Attachment

Indicator	Description
1	Lock indicator
2	Turn counterclockwise to unlock
3	Turn clockwise to lock

Turn off the device while attaching and detaching the earpiece.


Detaching the Earpiece

Best Practice



For optimum microphone performance, place the microphone closer and facing your mouth when transmitting.

180° Rotatable Speaker for Left and Right Wearing Configuration




Attaching the Earpiece



1. Insert the audio jack connector into the device audio jack.
